## 2010 Lot 49 Riesling “Cuvée Molly Devine”

“The Lot 49 excludes no middles. It’s neither simply dry nor obviously sweet, and avoids single interpretations altogether. What is certain is that this wine was grown on the steep, west-facing slope of an Old Mission Peninsula drumlin. It began its existence in the cool confines of stainless steel, then came to term in a 1200 liter oak Stück.”

### Winemaker Notes:

Try Dry!: This wine is a special “single-block” bottling of Clone #49 Riesling from our Bailiwick Vineyard. 2010 was an unusually warm and long growing season that lent itself well to making a drier style of Riesling from this site because of the very ripe fruit sugars and relatively softer acidity.

### Cuvée Molly Devine:

This wine shares its birth year with my first daughter Molly Devine O’Keefe. We hope that with proper care this wine will gracefully mature for years to come, so that someday Molly too will enjoy a sip of her eponymous wine.
